This policy establishes how the North East Texas Regional Mobility Authority ("NET RMA") will use information we gather from you about you from your visit to this Site (i.e. www.netrma.org) or any other information about you that you provide via any other form of communication including email, text and telephone. Regardless of the information being transmitted to NET RMA, we will protect all such information consistent with applicable laws. The privacy of our customers is of utmost importance to NET RMA. By using our services or communicating with us, you are agreeing, and hereby agree, to be bound by this privacy policy and any other terms and conditions of use of NET RMA.

Notice Regarding Texas Public Information Act

NET RMA is an independent government agency. As a government entity under Chapter 370 of the Texas Transportation Code, NET RMA is subject to any requests for disclosure under the Texas Public Information Act, Chapter 552 of the Texas Government Code. All information, with certain limited exceptions, provided to NET RMA through the website or otherwise by you may be subject to disclosure to the public upon request.

In compliance with Section 552.137 of the Texas Government Code, other than addresses provided in relation to certain business activities as described in Section 552.137(c), an email address you provide to NET RMA for the purpose of communicating with NET RMA is confidential and may not be disclosed without your permission, except to another governmental body or federal agency.

You are entitled to have us correct any information about you that is incorrect under Section 559.004 of the Texas Government Code.

Notice of Monitored Use

This Site is for authorized use only. This Site is monitored to ensure proper operation, to verify the function of applicable security features, and other similar purposes. Unauthorized access is prohibited. Attempts to access or use this Site for any reason other than its intended purposes are prohibited and may violate the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act of 1986 or other statutes and regulations, which could subject you to civil and criminal liability.

The following definitions apply to this Privacy Policy:

Aggregate Data – This is a set of data derived from data concerning a group or category of individuals or vehicles. The data set provides generic summary information about the group or category but does not contain information that would identify a specific individual or vehicle.

Cookie – This is a small text file that may be placed or accepted to be placed on your computer to allow us: to collect technical information about your activities on the Site; to make it possible for

you to use our Site to purchase goods or services, such as a tag; or to perform other tasks to facilitate your use of the Site.

Location Data or Location Information - This is mobile device geo-location data, which can be obtained from GPS, cellular, Wi-Fi services, your computer or mobile device IP address. Transaction Data or Transaction Information - Transaction Data or Transaction Information are details relating to the transactions made to use or access NET RMA services or infrastructure.

Personal Information Collected

NET RMA collects information from you when you register, place an order, subscribe to a newsletter or alert, fill out a form, enter information, communicate with us, use this Site or use NET RMA services or infrastructure.

How We Use, Share, and Protect Personal Information

We may use or disclose personal information covered by this Privacy Policy for the purpose for which it was provided, as well as in any manner consistent with this Privacy Policy and law. We acquire, use, share, and exchange personal information to and with third parties for our business operations, collections, security, research, improving our Sites or services, marketing, compliance with law (including the Texas Public Information Act), cooperation with law enforcement, enhancing public safety, protecting our rights or property and the rights or property of others, or communicating with you

We may use this information in the following ways:

+ To allow you to use this Site, our services and our infrastructure.

+ To personalize user's experience and to allow NET RMA to deliver the type of content and product offerings in which you are most interested.

+ To improve our Site and services to better serve you.

+ To communicate with you about our services, including by sending periodic emails, texts or other alerts regarding important matters, including via text messages to your mobile phone.

+ To process your transactions and collect tolls.

The information you voluntarily provide to NET RMA may be disclosed to a third party for the limited purposes of using your information as set forth above. Otherwise, NET RMA will not disclose your information to a third party unless you agree to its release or unless required by law, court order, or as legally required to do so in connection with law enforcement investigations or other legal proceedings. NET RMA or its third party contractors do not sell, trade, or lease your personal information to anyone.

To protect your personal information from unwanted disclosure, NET RMA takes reasonable steps to secure such data including by storing such data in secured networks that accessible only by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems and are required to keep the information confidential. We employ certain commercially available security measures to secure and protect the information that you provide or that we receive about you. We also require assurances that our service providers will follow industry practice to protect your personal information that we entrust to them.

Information Collected and Stored Automatically

NET RMA may use Cookies collected during your visit to this website for the purpose of facilitating your use of our website and for maintaining statistics concerning your use of our website that will help us make improvements. Technical information collected by Cookies will not be linked to your personal information. Such information will be used to compile Aggregate Data.

Log Activity for Statistical Analysis

NET RMA may use Aggregate Data and provide Aggregate Data to others to generate statistical reports that may be useful to provide improved services and infrastructure. NET RMA also tracks activity on its Site in the form of log files on web servers. These logs may be analyzed by third-party statistical analysis software solutions, including Google Analytics. These files log visitors to the website, usually a standard procedure for hosting companies and a part of hosting services analytics. The information inside the log files may include internet protocol ("IP") addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider ("ISP"), date/time stamp, referring/exit pages, and possibly the number of mouse clicks.
