Tyler, TX – March 3, 2016 – – The North East Texas Regional Mobility Authority (NET RMA) Board of Directors met Tuesday for their monthly board meeting at the Mineola Civic Center in Mineola, Texas. Among the topics on the agenda was the discussion and action on the recommendation of a firm for the build of Segment 4, Toll 49. The Board selected Webber, LLC the lowest bidder at \$68.7M, for the construction. Webber is one of the state's largest transportation companies.

Segment 4 of Toll 49, also called the Lindale Relief Route, is a 6.6-mile segment that stretches from I-20 to US 69 North of Lindale. It will be a 2-lane undivided road, projected to be complete in 2018. "We are excited about the forward momentum on the next section of Toll 49," said Everett Owen, Interim Executive Director of the NET RMA.
