- · Meets with project managers to identify objectives, needs and issues concerning project contracts.
- · Coordinates roadway maintenance, roadway activities and all other roadway matters.
- · In the absence of the Maintenance Director, recommends major maintenance, construction and betterment programs to the Executive Director and NET RMA Board.
- · Oversees routine and Preventive Maintenance programs and the development and preparation of maintenance contracts.
- · Assist in the development and monitoring of maintenance budget.
- · Provides technical and administrative support regarding contracts, billing, payment, and warrant actions; provides assistance, handles complaints, resolves discrepancies and problems.
- · Oversees inspection of construction methods and workmanship to ensure roadways, bridges, traffic signals and related structures are constructed according to plans and specifications.
- · Maintains highways and right-of-way by performing skilled roadway repair, highway markers and signs; hauls materials and equipment to job sites; removes litter, roadway hazards and roadway debris.

- · Audits payment invoices for completeness, accuracy, and compliance with terms of contract and governmental contracting rules, regulations, and procedures.
- · Performs preventive maintenance inspections (PMI), routine servicing and minor repairs on equipment and completes various required reports including timekeeping equipment forms, inventory, and PMI.
- · Assists with traffic control; places and gathers cones, warning signs, barricades, and flags.
- · Assists in providing support to local law enforcement officials at accident sites and assists stranded motorists, as necessary.
- · Inspects traffic control devices and placement at construction and maintenance sites for compliance with specifications for devices, safety laws, rules, regulations, and the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
