Notice of Traffic Disruption

On the morning of Friday November 11th, CH2M Hill, the NET RMA's Design/Build contractors, will be disrupting traffic at the intersection of SH 64 and Toll 49. The installation of concrete bridge beams will be taking place requiring closure of the eastbound lane; cranes will be used in the placement process therefore potentially hindering traffic flow. Flaggers will be directing traffic on the remaining open lane during this period between 9AM-12PM. Motorists are encouraged to find alternate routes to avoid potential delays in the construction area.
