Notice of Temporary Closure of CR 1145

Tyler, Texas – July 11, 2011

The NET RMA would like to announce that the Design / Build Contractor, CH2M Hill is advancing the construction on Segment 3B of Toll 49. CH2M Hill is currently working North of HWY 31 and moving north. The construction has reached a point of progress to where a portion of CR 1145 will be temporarily closed starting the week of July 27, 2011 to construct the CR 1145 bridge over Toll 49. There will be message boards set up to remind traffic, area residents and businesses of the impending closure starting July 14, 2011. Detour signage will be installed to assist motorists during the closure. Please allow for potential delays in the area.

Once the project is completed, Segment 3B will connect HWY 31 to I-20 finishing off the nearly 26 miles of roadway of Toll 49. Motorists will then be able to drive non-stop from HWY 110 in Whitehouse to I-20. The projected date of completion for Segment 3B is early January 2013.
