Construction Continues On Toll 49 At FM 724

CH2M Hill continues to work at the intersection of Toll 49 and FM 724. The work consists of constructing a bridge over the existing FM 724, realignment of CR 1148 and widening of FM 724. A one-lane flagging operation will continue to used be during the widening process of FM 724. Please allow for potential delays in this area.

CR 1148 to the east of FM 724 will be temporarily closed starting the week of October 24, 2011 to allow for CH2M Hill to widen the pavement along FM 724. Motorists may use an alternate route of either CR 1149 or CR 1151.

CH2M Hill was selected by the NET RMA to construct Segment 3B from SH 31 to I-20. CH2M Hill began construction in May, 2011 and the project is anticipated to be complete in early 2013.
