**NORTH EAST TEXAS REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS FOR PROJECT DIRECTOR**

The North East Texas Regional Mobility Authority ("NET RMA") was created through the joint efforts of Smith and Gregg Counties with the intended purpose of enhancing mobility and creating economic opportunity in the North East Texas region. Its creation was approved by the Texas Transportation Commission. Subsequent to the initial formation of the NET RMA, the Counties of Bowie, Cass, Cherokee, Harrison, Panola, Rusk, Titus, Upshur, Van Zandt, and Wood were added to the authority. The NET RMA now consists of 12 counties and is governed by a Board of Directors comprised of nineteen members appointed by the commissioners courts of the member counties and a chairperson appointed by the Governor. The NET RMA is currently pursuing the development and operation of the Toll 49 Project and also plans to pursue the future development of additional roadway projects and other transportation and mobility projects throughout the NET RMA region as authorized under the RMA Act (Chapter 370, Transportation Code).

The NET RMA is soliciting applications from individuals interested in providing the authority with Project Director services. The Project Director will act as an independent contractor and will not be an employee of the NET RMA. The Project Director will, with general guidance and oversight of the NET RMA Board of Directors, perform administrative and managerial work on behalf of the NET RMA including, but not limited to, administering and coordinating programs and projects; managing budgets; coordinating with and overseeing the NET RMA's general engineering consultant and other contractors; ensuring work quality and adherence to established policies and procedures; and performing additional related work and tasks as directed.

**Examples of the types of tasks that the Project Director will perform are listed below:**

- Plan, organize, and coordinate the functions of the NET RMA to meet established goals and objectives.
- Evaluate program operations and NET RMA policies and procedures and formulate recommendations for necessary revisions or improvements.
- Oversee the financing, construction, and operation of the Toll 49 Project and future NET RMA projects, including monitoring work progress, managing consultants, monitoring contract compliance, and maintaining administrative records.
- Provide updates and advice to the NET RMA Board of Directors regarding the Toll 49 Project and future NET RMA projects.
- Participate in the development, analysis, formulation, and administration of the NET RMA's annual budget; develop forecasts of necessary funds for staffing, equipment, materials and supplies; approve expenditures pursuant to guidelines established by the Board of Directors; and implement budget adjustments as necessary.
- Provide information, resources, and support to developers, builders, contractors, and the general public regarding NET RMA policies and procedures.
- Supervise NET RMA consultants and verify work product for accuracy, proper methodology, appropriate expenditures, and compliance with standards and specifications.
- Participate in preparation of procurement documents, attend pre-bid meetings to clarify scope of projects, review contract bids and proposals, and participate in selection of consultants and contractors.
- Negotiate and administer contracts as assigned and in coordination with the NET RMA's legal counsel.
- Serve as a representative and liaison for the NET RMA to the Texas Department of Transportation and other organizations, including local, state, and federal agencies.

The Project Director should have knowledge of the transportation and tolling industries and the standards applicable to those industries. The Project Director should also have knowledge of management and business principles and practices applicable to both private business and public administration; knowledge of advanced principles of budget preparation, analysis, forecasting and controls; ability to direct and coordinate various NET RMA programs and projects, including supervising, training and evaluating staff; knowledge of standard office equipment, computers, and word processing and spreadsheet programs; ability to perform research and problem-solving; ability to prepare, review and evaluate bids, cost estimates, change orders and related financial impact analyses; and ability to prepare clear and concise reports. Strong oral and written communication skills are critical to the job, and the candidate should have the ability to communicate effectively with NET RMA personnel, governmental officials, contractors, consultants, and the general public. The position will report directly to the NET RMA Board of Directors.

All applicants must be a licensed Professional Engineer in Texas and have, at a minimum 10 years experience, with some experience in tolling systems or toll operations.

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee to identify the applicant best qualified to serve the NET RMA. The final selection of a Project Director, if any, will be made by the NET RMA Board of Directors based upon the recommendation of the selection committee following completion of review of the applications and, if desired by the Authority, interviews. Execution of a contract will be subject to negotiation of a services agreement between the NET RMA and the Project Director.

All applicants must submit five copies of their resume, a letter of interest, and a list of three references.
